<p><u>Option 2:</u></p> <p>Rhythm Chart SHOW and TELL!</p>	<p>For this one, you will count and play through one of our recent rhythm charts (at least 4 lines!). Use a metronome set to 72 bpm.</p> <p>When ready to SHOW and TELL, you will fill out the <i>SHORT</i> form in our Google classroom which includes a way to upload a video of yourself ROCKIN' your RHYTHMS!</p>
<p><u>Option 3:</u></p> <p>Music THEORY!!!!</p>	<p>On the Lesher enrichment website, do a theory lesson. E-mail Mrs. Obluda to tell her what you learned.</p>
<p><u>Option 4:</u></p> <p>SIGHT-READING FACTORY!!!!</p>	<p>Explore and learn about Sight-reading Factory. E-mail Mrs. Obluda and give her an update on your progress.</p>
