FAQ's

What if one person wants to give to support two or more people?

They can still write one check. Have them either include two cards, or write on the card or a slip of paper who they are supporting so that credit can be given to the proper students.

How many letters can I send out?

This is OPTIONAL. However, if you want to participate, I suggest a minimum of 10, although you can do as many as you want. Many will do more than 30 letters. The more you send out the more likely you will get your money raised for this trip.

What happens if I raise more money than what is required?

Because this is a donation to the Orchestra PSA Fund, it is permanent and not refundable to anyone even if you reach your goal. Extra funds raised will go to help everyone (split between members as a whole). "No One Get's Left Behind!!" So if you raise more than you need . . . it is a good thing.

If someone tells me they are going to give, but then nothing comes in, what should I do?

Ask them. Don't pester them. Sometimes, people are busy and just forget. It would be appropriate for you to politely ask. This is also important to make sure it didn't get lost in the mail or returned or something.

What if I know a certain person is going to be asked by more than one person in the orchestra?

Still ask them. It is ok if multiple students ask a person. The whole community knows we're going on this trip, and hopefully many will designate a special gift to the orchestra fund and honor several students to give them credit to their account.

Is this the only way we're raising money?

This is just one of several fund raisers we'll be doing over the course of the school year, but I believe this will have the most impact.

What if I get all of my money raised?

Please strongly consider helping everyone else raise their money. **NO ONE GETS LEFT BEHIND!!!** It will take all of us working together.
